Defining the problem

- Statutory obligations; defining victim notification responsibilities
- Multiple jurisdictional Victim Notification Systems (VNS)
- Incomplete stakeholder engagement
- Many input sources; varying data
- Unsupported VNS used by jails
- Lack of funding
- Doing the right thing (inconsistency)
- Multiple “touch points” for victims
- Distinguishing “victims” from “interested parties”

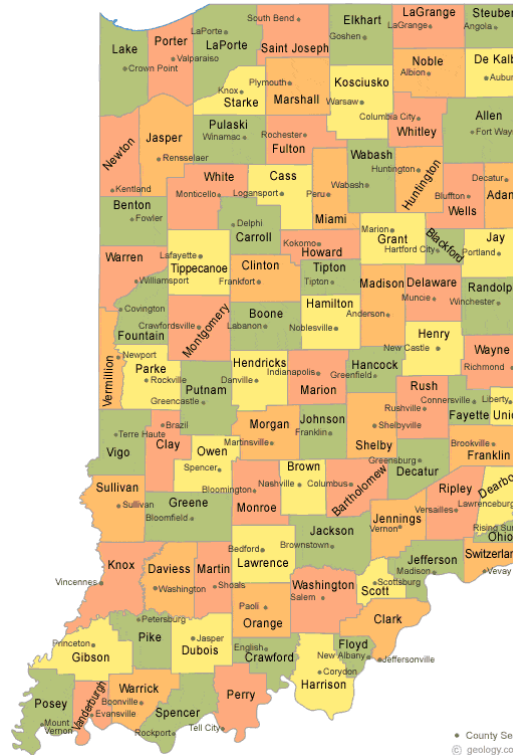
